

Addendum to GP Practice Privacy Notices (11 August 2021):

In order to provide you with the right level of care, from the right professional, and at the right time, the Practice works with third sector organisations to deliver the following projects :-

Tier Zero – Mental Health Referral Project

This is a Psychological Interventions Service to support patients with low level mental health conditions. GP practices make referrals to the following organisation for patients registered with the practice:

- **Cardiff MIND**

Community Connectors

This project supports patients to connect with local community services and organisations which may be useful to their health and wellbeing. The GP practice makes referrals to the following organisation for this service:

- **Cardiff MIND** are the specialist provider of this service.

Asylum Seekers Support Services (From September 20th 2021)

This project will support Asylum Seekers living in the local area. Patient information will also be shared with the consent of the patient to the following provider:

- **The British Red Cross** as the specialist provider of this service.

What Information is shared with these Organisations?

Patient information will be shared with these organisations via your GP. This will be done with your consent to share your confidential information. The information shared is your:

- Name
- Date of Birth
- Address
- Telephone contact number
- Gender
- Sexual orientation
- Ethnicity
- Reason for referral.
- Safeguarding and risk information.
- Referral consent and contact permissions.

The legal bases for sharing your information under these projects:

- **Article 6(1)(e)** – Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller.

- **Article 9(2) (h)** – Processing is necessary for the purposes of preventive or occupational medicine, for the assessment of the working capacity of the employee, medical diagnosis, the provision of health or social care or treatment or the management of health or social care systems and service.

Additional Information

- To further support patients, and to ensure that these organisations can help you, the Practice needs to **share your personal information with them**. This information will be kept to a minimum (as described above), and may include a brief summary of the support that your GP feels will be helpful.
- The sharing of these details will be managed in such a way to assure that it **remains confidential**, and any organisation that either shares or receives your information has a duty of confidentiality and to ensure that the personal data of **patients is shared and stored securely**.
- A **“Secure File Share Portal”** is currently used as a method for sharing Patient information securely. The Secure File Sharing Portal is a system hosted by **Digital Health and Care Wales (DHCW)**.
- These organisations will not share patient information further unless they have received your **explicit consent in a writing**. These organisations may share information that they have collected during patient assessments with your GP.

If you are a Patient, and you do not want your information to be shared with the third sector organisations listed above, please contact the Practice reception, or you can advise your GP at your consultation
