Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI):

Screening for chlamydia and gonorrhoea is available at all clinics, but we recommend that men who have sex with men and people who have noticed genital problems e.g. abnormal discharge, lumps, ulcers etc go to Cardiff Royal Infirmary. We offer a full service there, including screening for blood borne viruses - syphilis, hepatitis and HIV.

Emergency contraception lasts for 3 days and sometimes five days after unprotected sex. This is available at all our sexual health clinics, GP surgeries and some pharmacies.
